President's Report (Tia Ly):

Thanks everyone who volunteered for Fun Day, Spirit Wear, Birthday Books, Cards for a Cause, Diwali, Family Photo Shoot and Charleston Wrap.

<u>Treasurer's Report (Shweta Dixit):</u>

Our total expenditures \$22,536.45 with \$11,074.96 income. Big chunk this month was contribution to school field trips. Back to school picnic we broke even. Thank you to Patty and Heather for the Back-to-School Picnic. \$4080.53 in membership dues has been received. Fun day totals are still coming in. Tia and 5th grade fundraising team \$5,067.58 so far – Bravo! Turkey Trot Total was \$5,143.74, more than twice which was raised last year.
